

## **LEGAL NOTICE**

### **STOW ROAD WATERLINE REPLACEMENT – PHASE III PROJECT**

Sealed bids will be received by the Director of Public Service in the City of Stow, Ohio, until 12:00 Noon EST, September 20, 2012 and then publicly opened in the Boards and Commissions Room at City Hall, 3760 Darrow Road, Stow, Ohio, pursuant to Ordinance No. 2012-117 for the Stow Road Waterline Replacement – Phase III Project in accordance with the specifications on file in the Public Service Department.

Detailed information, blank proposals, and complete specifications may be obtained from the Director of Public Service. Bidders must use the forms and computer disk provided. Each proposal must contain the full name of the party(ies) making the same, and all persons interested therein.

A **mandatory** pre-bid meeting shall be held at Stow City Hall, 3760 Darrow Road, Stow, Ohio at 9:00 a.m. EST on September 12, 2012 in the Boards and Commissions Room.

Each bidder must furnish with its proposal a bid guaranty and contract bond in accordance with Ohio Revised Code Section 153.54.

Each bidder must submit evidence of its experience on projects of similar size and complexity, and list all subcontractors to be used.

Bidders must comply with the laws governing the prevailing rate of wages to be paid to persons employed on public improvements and with all EEO regulations.

Disadvantage Business Requirement – the DBE Goal is 8%.

The City of Stow, in determining the lowest, responsive, and responsible bidder in the award of this contract, may award a local bidder preference to any qualified bidder. The determination of whether a bidder qualifies for the local preference shall be made by the Board of Control; that decision shall be final.

The City of Stow reserves the right to reject any or all bids and to waive any informalities or irregularities in the bids received, and to accept any bid in part or in whole, which is deemed most favorable to the City of Stow at the time and under the conditions stipulated.
