

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AN EXPENDITURE FOR THE PURCHASE OF PARTS AND REPAIR OF FIRE EQUIPMENT FROM STATE OF OHIO COOPERATIVE PURCHASING PROGRAM OHIO MACHINERY FOR THE CALENDAR YEAR 2016, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Service Director has requested authorization for the purchase of parts and repair of fire equipment from State of Ohio Cooperative Purchasing Program Ohio Machinery for the calendar year 2016; and

WHEREAS, the purchase is exempt from public bidding pursuant to C.O.S. 173.07(a)(1)F and C.O.S. 173.07 (b)(1)C; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to C.O.S. 173.10 the total amount of the expenditure requires legislative approval by this Council; and


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOW, COUNTY OF SUMMIT AND STATE OF OHIO:


SECTION 1. That the Finance Director be, and he hereby is, authorized to appropriate, encumber, and pay funds in an amount not to exceed Forty-One Thousand and 00/100 Dollars (\$41,000.00) to State of Ohio Cooperative Purchasing Ohio Machinery for the purchase of parts and repair of fire equipment for the calendar year 2016.

SECTION 2. This Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any committees or subcommittees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance was adopted pursuant to Section 4.11 Charter, and is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health and safety for the reason that all equipment must be in working order at all times for use by the Fire Department, and, pursuant to Section 4.13, Charter, shall take effect upon its adoption by Council and approval by the Mayor, otherwise at the earliest period allowed by law.


