

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF STOW TO ACCEPT GRANT FUNDS FOR THE PURPOSE OF PURCHASING TWENTY-FIVE (25) BODY CAMERAS AS WELL AS A LARGE VIDEO SERVER TO MANAGE THE VIDEOS FROM THE EDWARD BYRNE MEMORIAL JUSTICE ASSISTANCE GRANT (JAG) PROGRAM, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Stow has been granted a grant from the Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) Program for the purchase of twenty-five (25) body cameras as well as a large video server to manage the videos; and

WHEREAS, the entire expenditure will initially be paid from City funds, the grant will reimburse the City of Stow approximately Seventy Five percent (75%) after the purchase;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOW, COUNTY OF SUMMIT AND STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor be, and she hereby is, authorized to accept grant funds from the Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) Program in the amount of Thirty Thousand Eight Hundred and 00/100 Dollars (\$30,800.00) for twenty-five (25) body cameras as well as a large video server to manage the videos.

SECTION 2. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.

SECTION 3. This Resolution was adopted pursuant to Section 4.11, Charter, and is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health and safety for the reason of assuring the ability of the Stow Police Department's officers to be able to use said equipment for communications and everyday field operations, and, pursuant to Section 4.13, Charter, shall take effect upon its adoption by Council and approval by the Mayor, otherwise at the earliest period allowed by law.
