Delete: First and second sentence.

Add: The base widening must be made safe at the end of each

working day by ramping with a 304 compacted limestone wedge to protect the drop off at the edge of pavement. All trenches will be protected with the use of traffic safety

drums.

 Page 19/152 – SUM–SR 91 & Norton Road [Part 2] Temporary Ramping of Vertical Surfaces at Driveways.

Add To Existing Note:

Compacted 304 limestone may be used as the wedge on a short-term basis.

d. Page 4/103 and 5/103 – SUM-91-11.83 [Part 1].

The Typical Section currently shows a pavement cross slope of 0.016 and a 2 ft. wide shoulder cross slope of 0.04. To be consistent throughout the entire project, SUM-91-11.83 [Part 1] cross slope will be changed to 0.02 from the profile grade to the face of the curb to match SUM-SR 91 & Norton Road [Part 2]. Plan sheet revisions will be provided to the successful bidder.
