

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO MAKE AND ENTER INTO A PROFESSIONAL SERVICES CONTRACT WITH SOLAR TESTING LABORATORIES, INC. FOR GEOTECHNICAL ENGINEERING AND INSPECTIONS FOR THE SUM-91-11.83 PART 1 AND SUM 91 AND NORTON ROAD PART 2 PROJECTS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, pursuant to C.O.S. 173.07(a)(1)B and 173.07(b)(1)G, the City of Stow is authorized by law to retain professional and technical services without the necessity of public bids;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOW, COUNTY OF SUMMIT AND STATE OF OHIO:


SECTION 1. That the Mayor be, and she hereby is, authorized to make and enter into a professional services contract with Solar Testing Laboratories, Inc. for geotechnical engineering and inspections for the SUM-91-11.83 Part 1 and SUM 91 and Norton Road Part 2 Projects.

SECTION 2. That the Finance Director be, and he hereby is, authorized to appropriate, encumber, and pay funds in an amount not to exceed Thirty-Five Thousand and 00/100 Dollars (\$35,000.00) to Solar Testing Laboratories, Inc. for said services.

SECTION 3. This Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any committees or subcommittees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.



That this Ordinance was adopted pursuant to Section 4.11 Charter, and is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health and safety for the reason that said engineering services and inspections are necessary before the projects starting dates of May 1st, and, pursuant to Section 4.13 Charter, shall take effect upon its adoption by Council and approval by the Mayor, otherwise at the earliest period allowed by law.


