RESOLUTION NO. 2016-62

INTRODUCED BY RIEHL

A RESOLUTION CHANGING THE NAME OF CITY CENTER BOULEVARD, WHICH RUNS BETWEEN GRAHAM ROAD AND DARROW ROAD (S.R. 91) PAST THE STOW SAFETY CENTER, TO LOUIS A. DIRKER JR. BOULEVARD.

WHEREAS, in honor of the many years of dedicated service that Louis A. Dirker Jr. gave to the City of Stow as Police Chief, this Council desires to change the name of City Center Boulevard, which runs between Graham Road and Darrow Road (S.R. 91) past the Stow Safety Center, to Louis A. Dirker Jr. Boulevard;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOW, COUNTY OF SUMMIT AND STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the roadway known as City Center Boulevard, which runs between Graham Road and S.R. 91 past the Stow Safety Center, be, and the same is, hereby changed to Louis A. Dirker Jr. Boulevard, as a tribute to Louis A. Dirker Jr's. service and devotion to our community.


SECTION 2. That the City Engineer be, and he hereby is, directed to change the official thoroughfare map for the City of Stow to comply herewith.

SECTION 3. That the Clerk of Council be, and she hereby is, authorized and directed to send a certified copy of this resolution to the Summit County Tax Map Office in order that the official tax map can be amended.

SECTION 4. This Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any committees or subcommittees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.


SECTION 5. That this Resolution was adopted pursuant to Section 4.11 Charter, and shall take effect thirty (30) days after its adoption by Council and approval by the Mayor, otherwise at the earliest period allowed by law.
