

A RESOLUTION EXTENDING THE OFFICIAL GRATITUDE AND APPRECIATION OF THE CITIZENS OF THE CITY OF STOW TO SHARLENE RAMOS-CHESNES, CO-OWNER AND CEO OF INTERCHEZ LOGISTICS SYSTEMS, INC., FOR BEING RECOGNIZED AS “THE NORTHERN OHIO DISTRICT’S SMALL BUSINESS PERSON OF THE YEAR” BY THE U.S. SMALL BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION; EXTENDING THE OFFICIAL GOOD WISHES FOR FUTURE HEALTH AND PROSPERITY TO HER AND HER FAMILY; DIRECTING THE CLERK OF COUNCIL TO SERVE A CERTIFIED COPY OF THIS ENACTMENT UPON SAID SHARLENE RAMOS-CHESNES; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Sharlene Ramos-Chesnes is the Co-Owner and CEO of InterChez Logistics Systems, Inc. which is a full-service contract logistics and transportation management firm with specialization in domestic and international freight forwarding and document translations. The company offers engineered logistics solutions for manufacturers and supply chain partners that include all modes of domestic and international transportation, warehousing and supply chain management. The firm is a customs broker and its staff are international business experts; and

WHEREAS, nominees for the Small Business Administration’s “Small Business Person of the Year” are selected based on the following criteria: staying power, growth in the number of employees, increase in sales or unit volume, current and past financial performance, innovativeness of product or service offered, response to adversity, and contributions to community-oriented projects. Every year since 1960 the U.S. Small Business Administration takes the opportunity to highlight the impact of outstanding entrepreneurs, small business owners, and others from all 50 states and U.S. territories during National Small Business Week; and

WHEREAS, the Small Business Administration recognized Sharlene Ramos-Chesnes because her success has enriched the local economy, her entrepreneurial spirit helped foster and create many good jobs, and she is a leader and innovator in her industry;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOW, COUNTY OF SUMMIT AND STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That on behalf of the present Council, the City Administration, and all citizens of the City of Stow, Ohio, the official gratitude and appreciation of this City are hereby extended to Sharlene Ramos-Chesnes, Co-Owner and CEO of InterChez Logistics Systems, Inc., for being recognized by the Small Business Administration as “The Northern Ohio District’s Small Business Person of the Year”. This Council declares that her contributions are most significant and typify the highest ideals of those persons in this profession. This Council further extends the official best wishes of this community for future health and prosperity to Sharlene Ramos-Chesnes and her family.

SECTION 2. That the Clerk of Council be, and she hereby is, authorized and directed to cause a certified copy of this enactment to be served upon Sharlene Ramos-Chesnes, and to have the same spread upon the permanent records of the City for all those who follow to emulate.


SECTION 3. This Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any committees or subcommittees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.

SECTION 4. This Resolution was adopted pursuant to Section 4.11, Charter, and is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health

and safety for the reason that it is fair and just to immediately recognize the devoted and enduring contributions made to this community by Sharlene Ramos-Chesnes, and, pursuant to Section 4.13, Charter, shall take effect upon its adoption by Council and approval by the Mayor, otherwise at the earliest period allowed by law.
