REQUESTED BY LAW DIRECTOR

INTRODUCED BY RASOR

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AN EMPLOYMENT CONTRACT BETWEEN THE CITY OF STOW AND SARA FAGNILLI AS A PART-TIME ASSISTANT LAW DIRECTOR FOR THE CITY OF STOW, ESTABLISHING COMPENSATION AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Sara Fagnilli is a skilled attorney with over thirty years' experience and expertise in the field of municipal law, labor and employment law, criminal law, and human resources for public entities that will benefit the City of Stow as a City employee with the Law Department; and

WHEREAS, the City of Stow desires to hire Sara Fagnilli for her experience and expertise for the benefit of the City of Stow and its residents.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOW, COUNTY OF SUMMIT AND STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor be, and she hereby is, authorized to make and enter into an employment contract with Sara Fagnilli as a part-time Assistant Law Director for the City of Stow, for a period of two years, in a form approved by the Law Director.


SECTION 2. That the Finance Director be, and she hereby is, authorized to compensate and administer benefits to Sara Fagnilli pursuant to the terms and conditions contained in the employment contract attached hereto and made a part of this ordinance by reference.

SECTION 3. This Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any committees or subcommittees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with the law

SECTION 4. This Ordinance was adopted pursuant to Section 4.11, Charter, and is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health and safety for the reason of best serving the needs of the City, and, pursuant to Section 4.13, Charter, shall take effect upon its adoption by Council and approval by the Mayor, otherwise at the earliest period allowed by law.


