

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING FUNDS FOR THE CONTINUATION OF THE SNOWPLOW ASSISTANCE PROGRAM, IN THE CITY OF STOW, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Council determines it is a necessary public purpose to expend funds for the continuation of the Snowplow Assistance Program, which shall include driveways, sidewalks and walkways between the garage and the house for qualifying residents, for the 2016/2017 season;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOW, COUNTY OF SUMMIT AND STATE OF OHIO:


SECTION 1. That the Finance Director is hereby authorized to expend funds for the Snowplow Assistance Program in accordance with all applicable Rules and Regulations in an amount not to exceed Twelve Thousand Five hundred and 00/100 Dollars (\$12,500.00) during the 2016/2017 season. Said monies shall be disbursed by the Finance Department as approved by the City of Stow Board of Control in compliance with this Ordinance and the Snowplow Assistance Program Rules and Regulations, which have been amended to provide revised program standards to reduce its cost. The applicant will not be subject to the City of Stow for financial due diligence subject to a notarized statement affirming such income level.

SECTION 2. This Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any committees or subcommittees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance was adopted pursuant to Section 4.11, Charter, and is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health and safety in order to assist low income elderly or totally and permanently disabled residents with maintaining safe access to their homes as a result of major snow events, and, pursuant to Section 4.13, Charter, shall take effect upon its adoption by Council and approval by the Mayor, otherwise at the earliest period allowed by law.
