

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 2016-4 TO INCREASE THE AUTHORIZATION TO EXPEND FUNDS WITH THE CITY OF MACEDONIA FOR THE HOUSING OF PRISONERS, VIDEO ARRAIGNMENT AND RELATED EXPENSES FOR 2016 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOW, COUNTY OF SUMMIT AND STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That Ordinance 2016-4, particularly Section 1 thereof, which formerly read:

“SECTION 1. That the Finance Director be, and he hereby is, authorized to appropriate, encumber, and pay funds in an amount not to exceed Sixty Five Thousand One Hundred and 00/100 Dollars (\$65,100.00) for the housing of prisoners, video arraignment and related expenses to the City of Macedonia.”

be, and the same is, hereby amended to read henceforth as follows:


“SECTION 1. That the Finance Director be, and he hereby is, authorized to appropriate, encumber, and pay funds in an amount not to exceed Seventy Six Thousand Eight Hundred Forty Three and 52/100 Dollars (\$76,843.52) for the housing of prisoners, video arraignment and related expenses to the City of Macedonia.”

SECTION 2. That all other terms and provisions of Ordinance No. 2016-4, and relating legislation not amended herein, be, and the same are, hereby reaffirmed as if fully reappearing herein.

SECTION 3. This Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any committees and subcommittees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.


SECTION 4. That this ordinance was adopted pursuant to Section 4.11 Charter, and is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health and safety for the reason that the City must fulfill the agreement with the City of Macedonia and in turn continue its relationship for prisoner housing as needed, and, pursuant to Section 4.13 Charter, shall take effect upon its adoption by Council and approval by the Mayor, otherwise at the earliest period allowed by law.
