

AN ORDINANCE CONFIRMING THE LAW DIRECTOR'S APPOINTMENT OF RODNEY SCHOFIELD AS ASSISTANT LAW DIRECTOR OF THE CITY OF STOW FOR A PERIOD OF ONE (1) YEAR, ESTABLISHING COMPENSATION FOR SAID APPOINTEE, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Law Director desires to appoint Rodney Schofield as Assistant Law Director of the City of Stow, effective August 29, 2016, to temporarily replace Assistant Law Director Brendan Mackin who is being deployed overseas; and

WHEREAS, it is incumbent upon this Council to confirm this appointment before the same becomes final; and

WHEREAS, this Council deems that the appointee herein does possess the qualities necessary to fulfill the office of Assistant Law Director;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOW, COUNTY OF SUMMIT AND STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. The appointment by the Law Director of Rodney Schofield as Assistant Law Director of the City of Stow for a period of one (1) year or until the return of Brendan Mackin to the position of Assistant Law Director, whichever event shall occur last and the same is, hereby confirmed by this Council retroactive to August 29, 2016.

SECTION 2. That said appointee shall be in the unclassified service of this City, and shall perform such duties as are required by the Law Director.

SECTION 3. That the Finance Director be, and he hereby is, authorized and directed to pay unto said Rodney Schofield the sum of \$29.29 at Grade 12, which, along with employee benefits, shall be in accordance with the general payroll ordinance of the City of Stow.

SECTION 4. This Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any committees and subcommittees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.

SECTION 5. That this ordinance was adopted pursuant to Section 4.11 Charter, and is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health and safety for the reason that the filling of this position is critical to the operation of the Law Department, and, pursuant to Section 4.13 Charter, shall take effect upon its adoption by Council and approval by the Mayor, otherwise at the earliest period allowed by law.
