

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO MAKE AND ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH MOTT MACDONALD, WITHOUT THE NECESSITY OF PUBLIC BIDS, FOR DESIGN OF SAFETY IMPROVEMENTS TO THE DARROW ROAD/GRAHAM ROAD INTERSECTION AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, pursuant to C.O.S. Sections 173.07(a)(1)B and 173.07(b)(1)G, Mott MacDonald is a professional and technical services provider and a contract may be entered into without the necessity of public bids, as required by Ohio Statute and the Codified Ordinances of Stow;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOW, COUNTY OF SUMMIT AND STATE OF OHIO:


SECTION 1. That the Mayor be, and she hereby is, authorized to make and enter into a contract with Mott MacDonald for purposes of designing safety improvements to the Darrow Road/Graham Road Intersection.

SECTION 2. That the Finance Director be, and he hereby is, authorized to appropriate, encumber, and pay funds in an amount not to exceed Ninety-One Thousand Twenty-Two and 80/100 Dollars (\$91,022.80) to Mott MacDonald for said engineering services.

SECTION 3. This Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any committees or subcommittees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.


SECTION 4. That this Ordinance was adopted pursuant to Section 4.11 Charter, and is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health and safety in order to provide safety and reduce crashes at the Darrow Road/Graham Road intersection, and, pursuant to Section 4.13 Charter, shall take effect upon its adoption by Council and approval by the Mayor, otherwise at the earliest period allowed by law.
