

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND REQUESTING THE ADVANCEMENT OF LOCAL TAXES FROM THE SUMMIT COUNTY FISCAL OFFICER FOR THE TAX YEAR 2016 PAYABLE IN 2017 IN ACCORDANCE WITH O.R.C. SECTION 321.34, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Summit County Fiscal Officer has requested that local authorities request advancement of local taxes annually by resolution;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOW, COUNTY OF SUMMIT AND STATE OF OHIO:


SECTION 1. That the Summit County Fiscal Officer is hereby authorized and requested to advance any and all local taxes to the City of Stow for the year 2016, payable in 2017, to the extent appropriate and feasible.

SECTION 2. That the Clerk be, and she hereby is, authorized and directed to forward a certified copy hereof to the Summit County Fiscal Officer (Auditor).

SECTION 3. This Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any committees and subcommittees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.


SECTION 4. That this resolution was adopted pursuant to Section 4.11 Charter, and is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health and safety for the reason that the City of Stow is dependent on the immediate advance of the tax funds to balance its budget in 2016, and, pursuant to Section 4.13 Charter, shall take effect upon its adoption by Council and approval by the Mayor, otherwise at the earliest period allowed by law.
