RESOLUTION NO. 2017-4

A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING THE TRADITION THAT THE PRESIDENT OF COUNCIL WILL DONATE THE ADDITIONAL \$1,000 OF SALARY THAT HE/SHE RECEIVES TO CHARITABLE ORGANIZATIONS RECOGNIZED UNDER IRC 501(C)(3) THAT OPERATES IN STOW TO SERVE THE COMMUNITY.

WHEREAS, the Presidency of City Council is a privilege, and this Council deems that the position does not require additional salary beyond that paid to the other members of Council; and

WHEREAS, there are many worthy charities operating in the City of Stow that assist the community; and

WHEREAS, this Council deems it fitting and appropriate to begin the tradition for the President of Council hereafter to donate the additional salary amount that he/she receives to such charities;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOW, COUNTY OF SUMMIT AND STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Council of the City of Stow resolves that the President of Council, retroactive to calendar year 2016, shall be urged to donate the additional \$1,000 of his/her salary to charitable organizations recognized under IRC 501(c)(3) that operates in Stow to serve the community.


SECTION 2. That this Council further resolves that the President of Council shall be urged to use the \$1,000 gift to raise public awareness for the importance of donating to these particular Stow charities.

SECTION 3. To continue with the tradition beyond 2017, City Council shall vote by way of motion to urge the Council President to donate \$1,000 of his/her salary pursuant to this resolution for the current calendar year. Said motion shall appear on the council agenda no later than March 31 of each year. Said motion shall only pass upon the unanimous vote of all Council Members in favor thereof. If said motion does not pass by March 31 of such year, then the reduction of the president's annual salary by \$1,000 shall be placed on City Council's agenda within the next 60 days.

SECTION 4. This Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any committees or subcommittees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.

SECTION 5. This Resolution was adopted pursuant to Section 4.11, Charter, and shall take effect thirty (30) days after its adoption by Council and approval by the Mayor, otherwise at the earliest period allowed by law.
