

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO MAKE AND ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH PITNEY BOWES, WITHOUT THE NECESSITY OF PUBLIC BIDS, TO PROVIDE POSTAGE FOR THE CLERK OF COURTS' AND JUDGES' OFFICES FOR THE CALENDAR YEAR 2017 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, pursuant to C.O.S. Section 173.07(a)(1)G and 173.07(b)(1)A, Pitney Bowes is the sole source provider and a contract may be entered into without the necessity of public bids, as required by Ohio Statute and the Codified Ordinances of Stow;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOW, COUNTY OF SUMMIT AND STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor be, and she hereby is, authorized to make and enter into a contract with Pitney Bowes for purposes of providing postage for the Clerk of Courts' and Judges' Offices for the calendar year 2017.


SECTION 2. That the Finance Director be, and he hereby is, authorized to appropriate, encumber, and pay funds in an amount not to exceed Sixty Thousand and 00/100 Dollars (\$60,000.00) to Pitney Bowes for said postage.

SECTION 3. This Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any committees or subcommittees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.

SECTION 4. That this Ordinance was adopted pursuant to Section 4.11 Charter, and is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health and safety for the reason that the Clerk's office must send out certified mail on a daily basis, and, pursuant to Section 4.13 Charter, shall take effect upon its adoption by Council and approval by the Mayor, otherwise at the earliest period allowed by law.


