New Business

T-156 (V-2) ORDINANCE NO. 2022-XX AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 505, C.O.S., ENTITLED “ANIMALS AND FOWL,” PARTICULARLY AMENDING SECTION 505.01 THEREOF, ENTITLED, "DOGS AND OTHER ANIMALS RUNNING AT LARGE; NUISANCES," TO MODIFY SUBSECTIONS 505.01(c) AND 505.01(d) THEREOF.

T-240 A RESOLUTION AMENDING CHAPTER 123, C.O.S., ENTITLED, “COUNCIL,” AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.


Adjournment

The meeting adjourned at 6:41 p.m.


