New Business

Presentation – Stow-Munroe Falls Close-up Program

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T-240 A RESOLUTION AMENDING CHAPTER 123, C.O.S., ENTITLED, “COUNCIL,” AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

On February 10, 2022, Mr. McIntire sponsored and introduced T-240 for review of Council members. Mr. McIntire presented version 3 which included exhibit A, Council Rules as an attachment to Chapter 123.

T-289 AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 1317, C.O.S., ENTITLED “CONTRACTOR REGISTRATION,” PARTICULARLY AMENDING SECTION 1317.08 THEREOF, ENTITLED, "EXCEPTIONS."

Mr. Catalano explained that the current language implied that the owner had to do the work for the permit. The new language will allow an owner to use a contractor.



Adjournment


