

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AN EXPENDITURE FOR THE PURCHASE OF TWO (2) 2016 FORD UTILITY POLICE INTERCEPTORS AND ONE (1) 2015 FORD SEDAN POLICE INTERCEPTOR FROM STATE OF OHIO VENDOR STATEWIDE FORD LINCOLN MERCURY INC. AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Service Director has requested authorization for the purchase of two (2) 2016 Ford Utility Police Interceptors and one (1) 2015 Ford Sedan Police Interceptor from State of Ohio Vendor Statewide Ford Lincoln Mercury Inc.; and

WHEREAS, the purchase is exempt from public bidding pursuant to C.O.S. 173.07(a)(1)F and C.O.S. 173.07(b)(1)C; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to C.O.S. Section 173.10 the total amount of the expenditure requires legislative approval by this Council;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOW, COUNTY OF SUMMIT AND STATE OF OHIO:


SECTION 1. That the Finance Director be, and he hereby is, authorized to appropriate, encumber, and pay funds in an amount not to exceed Ninety Thousand Eight Hundred Forty-Nine and 00/100 Dollars (\$90,849.00) to State of Ohio Vendor Statewide Ford Lincoln Mercury Inc. for the purchase of two (2) 2016 Ford Utility Police Interceptors one (1) 2015 Ford Sedan Police Interceptor.

SECTION 2. This Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any committees or subcommittees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance was adopted pursuant to Section 4.11 Charter, and is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health and safety in order to provide a reliable replacement vehicle for the Police Department in order to better serve the public, and, pursuant to Section 4.13, Charter, shall take effect upon its adoption by Council and approval by the Mayor, otherwise at the earliest period allowed by law.




