

A RESOLUTION EXTENDING THE OFFICIAL GRATITUDE AND COMMENDATION OF THE CITIZENS OF THE CITY OF STOW TO THE STOW-MUNROE FALLS HIGH SCHOOL SPEECH AND DEBATE TEAM FOR TAKING FIFTH PLACE SWEEPS OUT OF 83 SCHOOLS AND RECEIVING "TOP SCHOOL IN PERFORMANCE" FOR FIRST PLACE RANKINGS IN THE DRAMA, HUMOR AND DUO INTERPRETATION EVENTS AT THEIR STATE TOURNAMENTS; DIRECTING THE CLERK OF COUNCIL TO SERVE A CERTIFIED COPY OF THIS ENACTMENT UPON SAID TEAM; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Stow-Munroe Falls High School Speech and Debate Team achieved a significant feat by taking fifth place sweeps out of 83 schools and receiving "Top School in Performance" for first place rankings in the drama, humor and duo interpretation events at their state tournaments; and

WHEREAS, all the members of the Stow-Munroe Falls High School Speech and Debate Team put forth many hours of practice and dedication in preparation for the championship competitions and the events preceding it; and

WHEREAS, this Council deems it fitting and appropriate to commend all the members of the Stow-Munroe Falls High School Speech and Debate Team for their participation in these competitions representing the City of Stow;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOW, COUNTY OF SUMMIT AND STATE OF OHIO:


SECTION 2. That the Clerk of Council be, and she hereby is, authorized and directed to cause a certified copy of this enactment to be served upon the Stow-Munroe Falls High School Speech and Debate Team and to have the same spread upon the permanent records of the City for all those who follow to emulate.

SECTION 3. This Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any committees or subcommittees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.

SECTION 4. That this resolution was adopted pursuant to Section 4.11 Charter, and is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health and safety for the reason that it is fitting and appropriate to immediately recognize the untiring, devoted contributions made to this community by all members of the Stow-Munroe Falls High School Speech and Debate Team, and pursuant to Section 4.13 Charter, shall take effect upon its adoption by Council and approval by the Mayor, otherwise at the earliest period allowed by law.


