

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AN EXPENDITURE FOR THE PURCHASE OF TWENTY-ONE (21) BALLISTIC VESTS WITH CARRIERS FROM STATE OF OHIO VENDOR DRELLISHAK & DRELLISHAK, INC. AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the current vests in the police department are guaranteed for five (5) years and then must be replaced to provide adequate protection and avoid incidents of material failure; and

WHEREAS, those current vests are approaching that lift-span; and

WHEREAS, the police department has applied for a grant that would reimburse one-half (1/2) of the cost, but has not received confirmation yet; and

WHEREAS, the Service Director has requested authorization for the purchase of twenty-one (21) ballistic vests with carriers from State of Ohio Vendor Drellishak & Drellishak, Inc.; and

WHEREAS, the purchase is exempt from public bidding pursuant to C.O.S. 173.07(a)(1)F and C.O.S. 173.07(b)(1)C; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to C.O.S. Section 173.10 the total amount of the expenditure requires legislative approval by this Council;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOW, COUNTY OF SUMMIT AND STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Finance Director be, and he hereby is, authorized to appropriate, encumber, and pay funds in an amount not to exceed Twenty-Two Thousand Seven Hundred Eighty-One and 33/100 Dollars (\$22,781.33) to State of Ohio Vendor Drellishak & Drellishak, Inc. for the purchase of twenty-one (21) ballistic vests with carriers.

SECTION 2. This Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any committees or subcommittees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.



That this Ordinance was adopted pursuant to Section 4.11 Charter, and is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health and safety for the reason that we must replace faulty equipment used to protect our safety forces in a timely manner, and, pursuant to Section 4.13, Charter, shall take effect upon its adoption by Council and approval by the Mayor, otherwise at the earliest period allowed by law.
