

ORDINANCE NO. 2016-81

REQUESTED BY SERVICE DIRECTOR

INTRODUCED BY RIEHL

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO MAKE AND ENTER INTO A FIVE-YEAR CONTRACT WITH KENT STATE UNIVERSITY, WITHOUT THE NECESSITY OF PUBLIC BIDS, TO PROVIDE ANNUAL MAINTENANCE OF THE CITY'S NEW WORLD CAD SYSTEM FOR 2016 - 2020 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, pursuant to C.O.S. Section 173.07(a)(1)E and 173.07(b)(1)D, Kent State University is an intergovernmental and preferred source provider and a contract may be entered into without the necessity of public bids, as required by Ohio Statute and the Codified Ordinances of Stow;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOW, COUNTY OF SUMMIT AND STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor be, and she hereby is, authorized to make and enter into a five-year contract with Kent State University for purposes of providing annual maintenance of the City's New World CAD System for 2016 - 2010.


SECTION 2. That the Finance Director be, and he hereby is, authorized to appropriate, encumber, and pay funds in an amount not to exceed Seventy Three Thousand Three Hundred Thirty Six and 00/100 Dollars (\$73,336.00) to Kent State University for the first year and years two (2) through five (5) would include approximately a 3% per year increase for said service.

SECTION 3. This Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any committees or subcommittees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.

SECTION 4. That this ordinance was adopted pursuant to Section 4.11 Charter, and is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health and safety for the reason that the City must have support for the CAD System at all times, and, pursuant to Section 4.13, Charter, shall take effect upon its adoption by Council and approval by the Mayor, otherwise at the earliest period allowed by law.




