

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO MAKE AND ENTER INTO A THREE YEAR CONTRACT WITH AT&T CORPORATION., WITHOUT THE NECESSITY OF PUBLIC BIDS, TO PROVIDE FIBER OPTIC CONNECTIVITY TO FIRE STATION NOS. 2 AND 3 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, pursuant to C.O.S. Section 173.07(a)(1)C and 173.07(b)(1)E, AT&T Corporation is the best practical source provider and a contract may be entered into without the necessity of public bids, as required by Ohio Statute and the Codified Ordinances of Stow;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOW, COUNTY OF SUMMIT AND STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor be, and she hereby is, authorized to make and enter into a three year contract with AT&T Corporation for purposes of providing fiber optic connectivity to Fire Station Nos. 2 and 3.


SECTION 2. That the Finance Director be, and he hereby is, authorized to appropriate, encumber, and pay funds in an amount not to exceed Fifty-Nine Thousand Six Hundred Ninety Seven and 00/100 Dollars (\$59,697.00) to AT&T Services, Inc. for said three years of services.


SECTION 3. This Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any committees or subcommittees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.

SECTION 4. That this ordinance was adopted pursuant to Section 4.11 Charter, and is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health and safety for the reason that dependable and adequate data transmission to and from the remote fire stations is a necessity, and, pursuant to Section 4.13, Charter, shall take effect upon its adoption by Council and approval by the Mayor, otherwise, at the earliest period allowed by law.
