

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO MAKE AND ENTER INTO A PROFESSIONAL SERVICES CONTRACT WITH EMH&T TO PROVIDE THE FINAL ENGINEERING FOR THE WETMORE PARK OUTLET STRUCTURE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Stow is authorized by law to retain professional and technical services through the RFP (informal bid) process defined in Section 173.07(a)(1)(b), 173.07(b)(1)G and 173.09, C.O.S.; and

WHEREAS, EMH&T has completed the preliminary drainage study in Storm Water District 2 and is familiar with this area; and

WHEREAS, this structure was recommended as one of the first improvements to take place in District 2;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOW, COUNTY OF SUMMIT AND STATE OF OHIO:


SECTION 1. That the Mayor be, and she hereby is, authorized to make a contract with EMH&T for purposes of providing the final engineering for the Wetmore Park Outlet Structure.


SECTION 2. That the Finance Director be, and he hereby is, authorized to appropriate, encumber, and pay funds in an amount not to exceed Twenty Five Thousand One Hundred Ninety and 00/100 Dollars (\$25,190.00) to EMH&T for said engineering services.

SECTION 3. This Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any committees or subcommittees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.

SECTION 4. That this Ordinance was adopted pursuant to Section 4.11 Charter, and is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health and safety in order to expedite storm water system improvements as necessary to protect public health and safety, and, pursuant to Section 4.13, Charter, shall take effect upon its adoption by Council and approval by the Mayor, otherwise at the earliest period allowed by law.
