

A RESOLUTION EXPRESSING THE OFFICIAL APPRECIATION AND GRATITUDE OF THE CITIZENS OF THE CITY OF STOW, OHIO TO THE RUBBER CITY KENNEL CLUB FOR ITS CONTRIBUTION TO THE STOW POLICE K-9 FUND; DIRECTING THE CLERK OF COUNCIL TO SERVE A CERTIFIED COPY OF THIS ENACTMENT UPON THE RUBBER CITY KENNEL CLUB; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, due to the death of K-9 Officer Colt, the Stow Police Department is in the process of acquiring another K-9 to service the citizens of Stow; and

WHEREAS, the Rubber City Kennel Club has made a major contribution to this fund in the amount of \$1,500; and

WHEREAS, this Council deems it fitting and appropriate to recognize the Rubber City Kennel Club for their contribution;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOW, COUNTY OF SUMMIT AND STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That on behalf of the present Council, the City Administration, and all citizens of the City of Stow, Ohio, the official gratitude and appreciation of this City are hereby extended to the Rubber City Kennel Club for its donation of \$1,500 to the Stow Police K-9 Fund. This Council declares that this contribution is significant and noteworthy and typifies the highest ideals of civic pride and zeal.

SECTION 2. That the Clerk of Council be, and she hereby is, authorized and directed to cause a certified copy of this enactment to be served upon the Rubber City Kennel Club and to have the same spread upon the permanent records of the City for all those who follow to emulate.

SECTION 3. This Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any committees or subcommittees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.

SECTION 4. This Resolution was adopted pursuant to Section 4.11, Charter, and is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health and safety for the reason that it is fair and just to immediately recognize the contribution made to this community by the Rubber City Kennel Club, and, pursuant to Section 4.13, Charter, shall take effect upon its adoption by Council and approval by the Mayor, otherwise at the earliest period allowed by law.
