

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING COMPENSATION FOR THE DEPUTY
FINANCE DIRECTOR/TAX ADMINISTRATOR CHRISTINE M. SNYDER IN
GRADE 14 OF THE GENERAL PAYROLL ORDINANCE AND DECLARING
AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Finance Director previously appointed and Council confirmed Christine
M. Snyder as Deputy Finance Director/Tax Administrator; and

WHEREAS, the position of Deputy Finance Director/Tax Administrator has been upgraded
from Job Grade Level 12 to Job Grade Level 14 in the City’s General Payroll Ordinance;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOW,
COUNTY OF SUMMIT AND STATE OF OHIO:


SECTION 1. That the initial compensation for Christine M. Snyder in the position of
Deputy Finance Director/Tax Administrator as upgraded to Job Grade Level 14 shall be \$35.82 per
hour, which along with employee benefits shall thereafter be in accordance with the general payroll
ordinance of the City of Stow.

SECTION 2. That said appointee shall remain in the unclassified service of this City as
provided in her appointing legislation Ordinance No. 2012-198, and shall perform such duties as are
delineated in the Codified Ordinances of Stow, and as may be required by the Finance Director, or
his/her designee, pursuant to the provisions of the Codified Ordinances of Stow.

SECTION 3. This Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council
concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this
Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any committees or subcommittees that
resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.

SECTION 5. This Ordinance was adopted pursuant to Section 4.11, Charter, and is hereby
declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health
and safety for the reason that appropriate, fair and equitable compensation for the Deputy Finance
Director/Tax Administrator position needs to be established as soon as possible, and, pursuant to
Section 4.13, Charter, shall take effect upon its adoption by Council and approval by the Mayor,
otherwise at the earliest period allowed by law.
