

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE FILING OF AN APPLICATION WITH THE AKRON METROPOLITAN AREA TRANSPORTATION STUDY (AMATS) FOR FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE WITH PROJECTS DESIGNATED AS THE DARROW ROAD SIDEWALK, ARNDALE ROAD RESURFACING, FISHCREEK ROAD RESURFACING, STOW ROAD RESURFACING, HUDSON DRIVE RESURFACING AND GRAHAM ROAD CORRIDOR PROJECTS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Akron Metropolitan Area Transportation Study (AMATS) is responsible for programming transportation projects eligible to receive Federal Highway Administration funds, and they have determined that STBG, TASA, and resurfacing funds are currently available for capital improvement projects; and

WHEREAS, the City of Stow desires financial assistance with the Darrow Road Sidewalk, Arndale Road Resurfacing, Fishcreek Road Resurfacing, Stow Road Resurfacing, Hudson Drive Resurfacing and Graham Road Corridor Projects under the "Funding Policy Guidelines"; and

WHEREAS, to the best of our knowledge the information contained in the project application is accurate and based on preliminary engineering; and

THE PURPOSE AND DESCRIPTION OF WORK: The Darrow Road Sidewalk Project includes new walk from Conwill Road to Fishcreek Road. The Arndale Resurfacing Project includes resurfacing and striping from Darrow Road to Stow Road. The Fishcreek Road Resurfacing Project includes resurfacing and striping from Celia Drive to Darrow Road. The Stow Road Resurfacing Project includes resurfacing and striping on Stow Road from S.R. 91 (Darrow Road) to Conwill Road. The Hudson Drive Resurfacing includes resurfacing and striping from Hidden Lakes to Springdale Road. The Graham Road Corridor Project includes resurfacing, signing, pavement markings and traffic control improvements from Fishcreek Road to Newcomer Road.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOW, COUNTY OF SUMMIT, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

SECTION 1. The Council of the City of Stow shall hereby authorize filing of the appropriate application with AMATS for financial assistance with the Darrow Road Sidewalk Project at an estimated cost of \$900,000, the Arndale Road Resurfacing Project at an estimated Cost of \$350,000, the Fishcreek Road Resurfacing Project at an estimated cost of \$700,000, the Stow Road Resurfacing Project at an estimated cost of \$200,000, the Hudson Drive Resurfacing Project at an estimated cost of \$500,000, and the Graham Road Corridor Project at the estimated cost of \$2,100,000.

SECTION 2. The City of Stow is responsible for procuring local funds for work in Stow and intends to diligently pursue the Darrow Road Sidewalk, Arndale Road Resurfacing, Fishcreek Road Resurfacing, Stow Road Resurfacing, Hudson Drive Resurfacing and Graham Road Corridor Projects.


SECTION 3. This Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees or subcommittees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.

SECTION 4. That this Resolution was adopted pursuant to Section 4.11, Charter, and is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health and safety for the reason that it is necessary to meet the application deadline of October 31, 2017, and, pursuant to Section 4.13, Charter, shall take effect upon its adoption by Council and

approval by the Mayor, otherwise at the earliest period allowed by law.
