

AN ORDINANCE CONFIRMING THE MAYOR'S APPOINTMENT OF RONALD CLUM TO THE POSITION OF YOUTH SPECIALIST WORKER IN THE YOUTH SERVICES DIVISION OF THE POLICE DEPARTMENT FOR THE CITY OF STOW; ESTABLISHING COMPENSATION FOR SAID APPOINTEE; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Mayor desires to appoint Ronald Clum to the position of Youth Specialist Worker in the Youth Services Division of the Police Department for the City of Stow, effective September 30, 2017; and

WHEREAS, it is incumbent upon this Council to confirm this appointment before the same becomes final; and

WHEREAS, this Council deems that the appointee herein does possess the qualities necessary to fulfill the Youth Specialist Worker position.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOW, COUNTY OF SUMMIT AND STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. The appointment by the Mayor of Ronald Clum to the position of Youth Specialist Worker in the Youth Services Division of the Police Department for the City of Stow be, and the same is, hereby confirmed by this Council effective as of September 30, 2017 or as of the effective date in the Mayor's actual letter of appointment.


SECTION 2. That said appointee shall be in the unclassified service of this City, and shall perform such duties as are delineated in the Codified Ordinances of Stow, and as may be required of her by the Mayor, or her designee, pursuant to the provisions of the Codified Ordinances of Stow.

SECTION 3. That the Director of Finance be, and he hereby is, authorized and directed to pay unto said Ronald Clum the initial sum of \$23.53 per hour, and once he has completed his LSW accreditation, the amount of \$24.53 per hour, which, along with employee benefits, shall thereafter be in accordance with the general payroll ordinance of the City of Stow.

SECTION 4. This Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any committees or subcommittees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.

SECTION 5. This Ordinance was adopted pursuant to Section 4.11, Charter, and is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health and safety for the reason that the filling of this position is critical in maintaining the appropriate level of youth services within the community, and, pursuant to Section 4.13, Charter, shall take effect upon its adoption by Council and approval by the Mayor, otherwise at the earliest period allowed by law.
