ORDINANCE NO. 2017-108

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE LAW DIRECTOR’S APPOINTMENT OF RODNEY SCHOFIELD AS ASSISTANT LAW DIRECTOR OF THE CITY OF STOW TO A PERMANENT APPOINTMENT, ESTABLISHING COMPENSATION FOR SAID APPOINTEE, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Law Director appointed Rodney Schofield as Assistant Law Director of the City of Stow effective August 29, 2016 to temporarily replace Assistant Law Director Brendan Mackin who was deployed overseas;

WHEREAS, the City recognizes the Law Department’s need for an additional Assistant Law Director and desires to amend Mr. Schofield’s appointing ordinance to make his appointment permanent; and

WHEREAS, this Council deems that the appointee herein does possess the qualities necessary to fulfill the office of Assistant Law Director;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOW, COUNTY OF SUMMIT AND STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That Ordinance 2016–100 which formerly read as follows:

“The appointment by the Law Director of Rodney Schofield as Assistant Law Director of the City of Stow for a period of one (1) year or until the return of Brendan Mackin to the position of Assistant Law Director, whichever event shall occur last and the same is, hereby confirmed by this Council retroactive to August 29, 2016.”

be, and the same is, hereby amended to read henceforth as follows:

“The appointment by the Law Director of Rodney Schofield as Assistant Law Director of the City of Stow is hereby confirmed by this Council effective immediately. Mr. Schofield shall be classified as a permanent full-time employee, exempt from the classified civil service.”

SECTION 2. That all other terms and provisions of Ordinance 2016-100 not amended herein, be, and the same are, hereby reaffirmed as if fully reappearing herein.

SECTION 3. This Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any committees and subcommittees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.


SECTION 4. That this ordinance was adopted pursuant to Section 4.11 Charter, and is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health and safety for the reason that the filling of this position is critical to the operation of the Law Department, and, pursuant to Section 4.13 Charter, shall take effect upon its adoption by Council and approval by the Mayor, otherwise at the earliest period allowed by law.
