

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO MAKE AND ENTER INTO RENEWAL CONTRACTS WITH WICHERT INSURANCE SERVICES, INC. AND LOVE INSURANCE AGENCY FOR GENERAL INSURANCE COVERAGE, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, quotes for the City's general insurance contracts were obtained in 2014 through the City's RFP process and renewed in 2015 and 2016, and based on the negotiations for renewal, the Administration recommends that the City's insurance coverage for the City of Stow be awarded for a one (1) year renewal period in 2017;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOW, COUNTY OF SUMMIT AND STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor be, and she hereby is, authorized to make and enter into a contract with Wichert Insurance Services, Inc., for the City's Building, Electronic Data Processing, Cyber, Automobile, General Liability, EMS, Umbrella and other related insurance policies and such renewal shall be deemed to be in conformance with C.O.S. Section 173.07(b)(1)F.


SECTION 2. That the Mayor be, and she hereby is, authorized to make and enter into a contract with Love Insurance Agency, for the City's Law Enforcement, Public Official Liability, Cyber and other related insurance policies and such renewal shall be deemed to be in conformance with C.O.S. Section 173.07(b)(1)F.

SECTION 3. That the Finance Director be, and he hereby is, authorized and directed to appropriate, encumber and pay funds for said insurance coverage in an aggregate amount not to exceed Two Hundred Forty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$245,000) for the 2017-2018 insurance year.

SECTION 4. This Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any committees and subcommittees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.

SECTION 5. That this ordinance was adopted pursuant to Section 4.11 Charter, and is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health and safety for the reason that it is immediately necessary to obtain the insurance coverage herein described in order to protect the City, and, pursuant to Section 4.13 Charter, shall take effect upon its adoption by Council and approval by the Mayor, otherwise at the earliest period allowed by law.


