

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING CHAPTER 731, C.O.S., ENTITLED  
“MECHANICAL AMUSEMENT DEVICES”, OF PART SEVEN, ENTITLED  
“BUSINESS REGULATIONS”, IN ITS ENTIRETY.

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Stow has determined that the City’s regulations  
regarding mechanical amusement devices are no longer necessary;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOW,  
COUNTY OF SUMMIT AND STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That Chapter 731, C.O.S., entitled “Mechanical Amusement Devices”, of Part  
Seven, entitled “Business Regulations”, be, and the same is, hereby repealed in its entirety.

SECTION 2. This Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council  
concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this  
Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any committees or subcommittees that  
resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.


SECTION 3. That this ordinance was adopted pursuant to Section 4.11 Charter, and shall
