

ORDINANCE NO. 2017-125

AN ORDINANCE ALLOCATING ORIGINAL AND SUPPLEMENTAL OVERTIME FUNDS FROM THE CITY OF STOW'S BUDGET FOR OVERTIME EXPENDITURES FOR THE FIRE AND POLICE DEPARTMENTS IN 2017 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOW, COUNTY OF SUMMIT AND STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. For the operating year 2017 the budget authorized City of Stow overtime expenditures to be limited and restricted to the following amounts for the combined line accounts of the departments specified below:

Fire Department	\$272,500 through December 2017
Police Department	\$350,000 through December 2017.

That those overtime expenditures be, and they hereby are, amended to read henceforth as follows:

Fire Department	Up to \$287,500 through December 2017
Police Department	Up to \$380,000 through December 2017.

SECTION 2. This Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any committees and subcommittees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance was adopted pursuant to Section 4.11 Charter, and is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health and safety for the reason that adequate overtime funds need to be allocated to said departments to provide necessary protection to the community, and, pursuant to Section 4.13 Charter, shall take effect upon its adoption by Council and approval by the Mayor, otherwise at the earliest period allowed by law.
