

ORDINANCE NO. 2018-14

INTRODUCED BY COSTELLO

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AN EXPENDITURE TO MARK F. LUCCO AS AND FOR SETTLEMENT OF HIS MORAL CLAIM AGAINST THE CITY FOR DAMAGE TO HIS VEHICLE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, on December 25, 2017, Mark F. Lucco incurred damage to his vehicle as a result of hitting a snowplow blade in the City of Stow; and

WHEREAS, on December 28, 2017, Mark F. Lucco submitted a moral claim in the amount of \$3,792.48 or \$4,147.44 to the City for the damage to his vehicle; and

WHEREAS, the Codified Ordinances of Stow provide moral claims in excess of \$1,000 shall be reviewed by the Board and submitted to Council for action within sixty (60) days of recommendation of such Board; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Control has recommended denial of this moral claim;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOW, COUNTY OF SUMMIT AND STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Finance Director be, and he hereby is, authorized to appropriate, encumber, and pay funds in an amount not to exceed Four Thousand One Hundred Forty-Seven and 44/100 Dollars (\$4,147.44) to Mark F. Lucco as and for settlement of his moral claim against the City for damage to his vehicle as a result of hitting a snowplow blade in the City of Stow.

SECTION 2. This Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any committees or subcommittees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance was adopted pursuant to Section 4.11 Charter, and is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health and safety for the reason that the City must resolve this moral claim in a timely manner, and, pursuant to Section 4.13, Charter, shall take effect upon its adoption by Council and approval by the Mayor, otherwise at the earliest period allowed by law.
