

RESOLUTION NO. 2018-41

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT FOR COOPERATION AND COST SHARING FOR THE PURCHASE OF SIGNAL POLES FOR TWO SEASONS ROAD/S.R. 8 INTERCHANGES WITH THE CITY OF HUDSON AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Stow and City of Hudson are eligible to receive ODOT/FHWA funding for the cost of signal equipment and the construction cost for the installation of signals as part of the S.R. 8 Reconstruction Project; and

WHEREAS, the City of Stow has enacted legislation authorizing its Mayor to enter into agreements with the Ohio Department of Transportation (ODOT) necessary for the completion of improvements to S.R. 8; and

WHEREAS, it is the mutual desire of both LPA, the City of Stow, and the City of Hudson, to have the City of Hudson bid out the signal poles for the two Seasons Road/S.R. 8 interchanges, which is the local public agency requirement to get ODOT to install the signals as part of the S.R. 8 Reconstruction Project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOW, COUNTY OF SUMMIT AND STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor is authorized to enter into an Agreement for Cooperation and Cost Sharing with the City of Hudson for the purchase of signal poles for two Seasons Road/S.R. 8 Interchanges.


SECTION 2. That the City of Stow and the City of Hudson will split 50%/50% the local share of the installation costs.


SECTION 3. This Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any committees or subcommittees that resulted in those formal actions, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.

SECTION 4. This Resolution was adopted pursuant to Section 4.11, Charter, and is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health and safety of the citizens of Stow for the reason that the S.R. 8 Reconstruction Projects is scheduled to begin in July of 2018, and, pursuant to Section 4.13, Charter, shall take effect upon its adoption by Council and approval by the Mayor, otherwise at the earliest period allowed by law.


