ORDINANCE NO. 2018-44

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 2013-63 TO CHANGE THE NAME OF THE POSITION OF DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE TO DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE/CHIEF OF STAFF AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Mayor Kline appointed Nick Wren Director of Public Service of the City of Stow on May 1, 2013; and

WHEREAS, Stow City Council subsequently confirmed the same; and

WHEREAS, Mayor Kline now wishes to expand the position to Director of Public Service/Chief of Staff; and

WHEREAS, this City Council concurs with that decision.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOW, COUNTY OF SUMMIT AND STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That Ordinance No. 2013-63, particularly Section 1 thereof, which formerly read:

“SECTION 1. The appointment by the Mayor of Nick Wren as Director of Public Service of the City of Stow be, and the same is, hereby confirmed by this Council effective May 1, 2013.”

be, and the same is, hereby amended to read henceforth as follows:


“SECTION 1. The appointment by the Mayor of Nick Wren as Director of Public Service/Chief of Staff of the City of Stow be, and the same is, hereby confirmed by this Council effective immediately.”

SECTION 2. That all other terms and provisions of Ordinance No. 2013-63, and relating legislation not amended herein, be, and the same are, hereby reaffirmed as if fully reappearing herein.

SECTION 3. This Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any committees and subcommittees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance was adopted pursuant to Section 4.11, Charter, and is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health and safety for the reason that the filling of this position is critical in maintaining effective and efficient municipal operations, and, pursuant to Section 4.13, Charter, shall take effect upon its adoption by Council and approval by the Mayor, otherwise at the earliest period allowed by law.
