ORDINANCE NO. 2018- 45

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO MAKE AND ENTER INTO A PROFESSIONAL SERVICES CONTRACT WITH ORCHARD HILTZ & MCCLIMENT INC. (OHM) TO PROVIDE CONSULTING SERVICES FOR VARIOUS SITES IN THE CITY AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Stow is authorized by law to retain professional and technical services through the RFP (informal bid) process defined in Sections 173.07(a)(1)b, 173.07(b)(1)G and 173.09, C.O.S.; and

WHEREAS, Orchard Hiltz & McCliment, Inc. (OHM) has been selected for this task given their extensive background in similar projects throughout the state, their familiarity of the land being considered and the superior service they have provided to the City on past projects;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOW, COUNTY OF SUMMIT AND STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor be, and she hereby is, authorized to make and enter into a contract with Orchard Hiltz & McCliment, Inc. (OHM) for purposes of providing consulting services for various sites in the City.

SECTION 2. That the Finance Director be, and he hereby is, authorized to appropriate, encumber, and pay funds in an amount not to exceed Thirty Thousand Four Hundred and 00/100 Dollars (\$30,400.00) to Orchard Hiltz & McCliment, Inc. (OHM) for said services.

SECTION 3. This Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any committees or subcommittees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.

SECTION 4. That this Ordinance was adopted pursuant to Section 4.11, Charter, and is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health and safety for the reason that this is a continuation of a long planning process that should be expedited as soon as possible, and, pursuant to Section 4.13, Charter, shall take effect upon its adoption by Council and approval by the Mayor, otherwise at the earliest period allowed by law.
