

ORDINANCE NO. 2018-62

REQUESTED BY POLICE CHIEF

INTRODUCED BY RIEHL

AN ORDINANCE CONFIRMING THE PROMOTION OF LIEUTENANT ANNE STIRM TO THE RANK OF CAPTAIN IN THE CITY OF STOW POLICE DEPARTMENT; ESTABLISHING COMPENSATION FOR SAID APPOINTEE; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Police Chief has recommended that Lieutenant Anne Stirm be promoted to the rank of Captain in the City of Stow Police Department; and

WHEREAS, this Council deems that Lieutenant Anne Stirm herein does possess the qualities necessary to fulfill the rank of Captain in the Police Department;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOW, COUNTY OF SUMMIT AND STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the promotion of Lieutenant Anne Stirm to the rank of Captain in the City of Stow Police Department be, and the same is, hereby confirmed by this Council effective as of April 30, 2018.


SECTION 2. That said appointee shall be in the unclassified service of this City, and shall perform such duties as are required by the Police Chief.


SECTION 3. That the Director of Finance be, and he hereby is, authorized and directed to pay unto said Captain Anne Stirm the initial sum of \$44.80 per hour, which, along with employee benefits, shall thereafter be in accordance with the / Payroll Ordinance of the City of Stow. General

SECTION 4. This Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any committees or subcommittees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.

SECTION 5. This Ordinance was adopted pursuant to Section 4.11, Charter, and is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health and safety in order to ensure that the Police Department has proper supervisory coverage while reducing supervisory overtime and, pursuant to Section 4.13, Charter, shall take effect upon its adoption by Council and approval by the Mayor, otherwise at the earliest period allowed by law.
