

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO MAKE AND ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH CORE & MAIN LP, WITHOUT THE NECESSITY OF PUBLIC BIDS, FOR THE PURCHASE OF 1300 MXU UNITS, MODEL 510 METER READING DEVICES NEEDED TO REPLACE THE CURRENT MXU DEVICES THROUGHOUT THE CITY AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, pursuant to C.O.S. Section 173.07(a)(1)(G) and 173.07(b)(1)(A), Core & Main LP is the sole source provider and a contract may be entered into without the necessity of public bids, as required by Ohio Statute and the Codified Ordinances of Stow;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOW, COUNTY OF SUMMIT AND STATE OF OHIO:


SECTION 1. That the Mayor be, and he hereby is, authorized to make and enter into a contract with Core & Main LP for the purchase of 1300 MXU units, model 510 meter reading devices needed to replace the current MXU devices throughout the City.


SECTION 2. That the Finance Director be, and he hereby is, authorized to appropriate, encumber, and pay funds in an amount not to exceed Seventy-One Thousand Five Hundred and 00/100 Dollars (\$71,500.00) to Core & Main LP for said devices.

SECTION 3. This Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any committees or subcommittees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.


SECTION 4. That this Ordinance was adopted pursuant to Section 4.11 Charter, and is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health and safety for the reason that we must have working MXUs at all times, and, pursuant to Section 4.13 Charter, shall take effect upon its adoption by Council and approval by the Mayor, otherwise at the earliest period allowed by law.
