

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT FOR COOPERATION AND COST SHARING WITH THE VILLAGE OF SILVER LAKE FOR CONSTRUCTION AND INSPECTION OF THE GRAHAM ROAD RESURFACING PROJECT LOCATED IN THE CITY OF STOW AND THE VILLAGE OF SILVER LAKE; COMMITTING THE CITY OF STOW AS SPONSOR; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Stow and the Village of Silver Lake are eligible to receive 80 percent federal STBG funding up to \$700,000 for the construction and inspection of the Graham Road Resurfacing Project; and

WHEREAS, the City of Stow has enacted legislation authorizing its Mayor to enter into agreements with the Ohio Department of Transportation (ODOT) necessary for the completion of the Project; and

WHEREAS, it is the mutual desire of both LPAs, the City of Stow and the Village of Silver Lake, to have the City of Stow serve as the responsible lead agency for construction and inspection of the project;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOW, COUNTY OF SUMMIT AND STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor is authorized to enter into an agreement with the Village of Silver Lake for the Graham Road Resurfacing Project.


SECTION 2. That the City of Stow and the Village of Silver Lake will split 46/54 of the local share of the construction costs with the Village of Silver Lake having more work within the Corporation Limits.


SECTION 3. This Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any committees or subcommittees that resulted in those formal actions, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.

SECTION 4. This Resolution was adopted pursuant to Section 4.11, Charter, and is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health and safety of the citizens of Stow and for the reason that it will allow construction to be bid this year, and, pursuant to Section 4.13, Charter, shall take effect upon its adoption by Council and approval by the Mayor, otherwise at the earliest period allowed by law.


