

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 2018-35 AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO MAKE AND ENTER INTO A THREE-YEAR CONTRACT WITH CONVERGEONE FOR THE AVAYA MAINTENANCE OF OUR TELEPHONE SYSTEM AT CITY HALL/SAFETY CENTER FOR THE PERIOD SEPTEMBER 1, 2018 THRU AUGUST 31, 2020, WITHOUT THE NECESSITY OF PUBLIC BIDS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, pursuant to C.O.S. Sections 173.07(a)(1)G and 173.07(b)(1)A, ConvergeOne is a sole source provider and a contract may be entered into without the necessity of public bids as required by Ohio Statute and the Codified Ordinances of Stow;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOW, COUNTY OF SUMMIT AND STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That Ordinance No. 2018-35 is hereby repealed in its entirety.


SECTION 2. That the Mayor be, and he hereby is, authorized to make and enter into a three-year contract with ConvergeOne for the Avaya maintenance of our telephone system at City Hall/Safety Center for the period September 1, 2018 thru August 31, 2020.

SECTION 3. That the Finance Director be, and he hereby is, authorized to appropriate, encumber, and pay funds in an amount not to exceed Twenty-Six Thousand Seventeen and 92/100 Dollars (\$26,017.92) for the first year, Twenty-Five Thousand Nine Hundred Five and 60/100 (\$25,905.60) for the second year and Twenty-Five Thousand Nine Hundred Five and 60/100 (\$25,905.60) for the third year for a total amount not to exceed Seventy-Seven Thousand Eight Hundred Twenty-Nine and 12/100 (\$77,829.12) for that three-year period to ConvergeOne for said services.

SECTION 4. This Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any committees or subcommittees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.


SECTION 5. That this ordinance was adopted pursuant to Section 4.11 Charter, and is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health and safety for the reason of insuring reliable phone communication services for public safety, and, pursuant to Section 4.13 Charter, shall take effect upon its adoption by Council and approval by the Mayor, otherwise at the earliest period allowed by law.
