

ORDINANCE NO. 2018-109

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 2018-57, WHICH AUTHORIZED AN EXPENDITURE FOR THE PURCHASE OF ONE (1) 2018 GMC 3500 4WD EXT CAB PICK-UP WITH PLOW PACKAGE FROM STATE OF OHIO VENDOR BOB ROSS BUICK, INC., TO CHANGE THE EXPENDITURE TO BE WITH STATE OF OHIO VENDOR M4 MOTORS FOR THE PURCHASE OF ONE (1) 2019 GMC SIERRA 2500 WITH PLOW, TO INCREASE THE AMOUNT OF THE EXPENDITURE, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Stow City Council had previously authorized an expenditure with State of Ohio Vendor Bob Ross Buick, Inc. for the purchase of one (1) 2018 GMC 3500 4WD Ext Cab Pick-Up with plow package as part of Ordinance No. 2018-57; and

WHEREAS, Bob Ross Buick, Inc. cannot provide us with the vehicle that we need; and

WHEREAS, because of that, the Service Director has requested authorization to amend that legislation to change the expenditure to be with State of Ohio Vendor M4 Motors for the purchase of one (1) 2019 GMC Sierra 2500 with plow and to increase the amount of the expenditure; and

WHEREAS, the purchase is exempt from public bidding pursuant to C.O.S. 173.07(a)(1)F and C.O.S. 173.07(b)(1)C; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to C.O.S. Section 173.10, the total amount of the expenditure requires legislative approval by this Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOW, COUNTY OF SUMMIT AND STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That Ordinance No. 2018-57 is hereby amended to change the authorized expenditure to be with State of Ohio Vendor M4 Motors instead of Bob Ross Buick, Inc. for the purchase of one (1) 2019 GMC Sierra 2500 with plow instead of one (1) 2018 GMC 3500 4WD Ext Cab Pick-Up with plow package and to change the authorized expenditure for said vehicle from Forty-Thousand Four Hundred Thirty-Four and 10/100 Dollars (\$40,434.10) to Forty-Thousand Seven Hundred Forty-Six and 00/00 Dollars (\$40,746.00).


SECTION 2. That all other terms and provisions of Ordinance No. 2018-57 and relating legislation not amended herein be, and the same are, hereby reaffirmed as if fully reappearing herein.

SECTION 3. This Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any committees and subcommittees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.

SECTION 4. That this ordinance was adopted pursuant to Section 4.11 Charter, and is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health and safety for the purpose of providing a reliable replacement vehicle for the Street Department in order to better serve the public, and, pursuant to Section 4.13 Charter, shall take effect upon its adoption by Council and approval by the Mayor, otherwise at the earliest period allowed by law.


