

## **LEGAL NOTICE**

### **SUM-CR29-2.34 Graham Road Resurfacing [PID 107812]**

Sealed bids will be received by the Chief of Staff/Director of Public Service in the City of Stow, Ohio, until 12:00 Noon EST, November 15, 2018 and then publicly opened in the Boards and Commissions Room at City Hall, 3760 Darrow Road, Stow, Ohio, pursuant to Ordinance No. 2018-93 for the SUM-CR29-2.34 Graham Road Resurfacing [PID 107812] in accordance with the specifications on file in the Public Service Department.

Detailed information, blank proposals, and complete specifications may be obtained from the Director of Public Service. Bidders must use the forms and computer disk provided. Each proposal must contain the full name of the party(ies) making the same, and all persons interested therein.

Each bidder must furnish with its proposal a bid guaranty and contract bond in accordance with Ohio Revised Code Section 153.54.

Each bidder must submit evidence of its experience on projects of similar size and complexity, and list all subcontractors to be used.

Bidders must comply with the laws governing the prevailing rate of wages to be paid to persons employed on public improvements and with all EEO regulations.

Disadvantaged Business (DBE) Requirement. DBE participation goals (subcontracts, materials, supplies) have been set on this project for those certified as DBE's in accordance with the TEA – 21 (1998) and 49 CFR, Part 26, and qualified to bid with ODOT under Chapter 5525 of the Ohio Revised Code (O.R.C.). At the beginning following the project identification, the DBE goal designation is written, i.e., DBE Goal: 7%.

Only ODOT pre-qualified contractors are eligible to submit bids for this project. Pre-qualification status must be in force at the time of the bid, at the time of the award, and through the life of the construction contract.

The City of Stow reserves the right to reject any or all bids and to waive any informalities or irregularities in the bids received, and to accept any bid in part or in whole, which is deemed most favorable to the City of Stow at the time and under the conditions stipulated.
