

RESOLUTION NO. 2018-115

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE SUMMIT PENTECOSTAL CHURCH TO SELL CHRISTMAS TREES IN THEIR PARKING LOT AT 1221 GRAHAM ROAD FROM NOVEMBER 26TH, 2018 THROUGH DECEMBER 24TH, 2018 AS A FUNDRAISER FOR ITS PROGRAMS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Summit Pentecostal Church has requested authorization to conduct a fundraiser for its programs by selling Christmas trees to the public; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Stow is desirous of allowing said usage in accordance with C.O.S. Section 1185.02(C)(2)(c);

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOW, COUNTY OF SUMMIT AND STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Summit Pentecostal Church be, and it hereby is, authorized to sell Christmas trees from the parking lot of 1221 Graham Road as a fundraiser for its programs from November 26th, 2018, through December 24th, 2018.


SECTION 2. That the Summit Pentecostal Church agrees to remove any unsold trees or debris which may be left after the fundraiser has terminated.


SECTION 3. That any and all fees required herein be, and the same are, hereby waived.

SECTION 4. This Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any committees or subcommittees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.

SECTION 5. That this resolution was adopted pursuant to Section 4.11, Charter, and is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health and safety for the reason that passage of this legislation will allow the applicant to begin sales on November 26th, and, pursuant to Section 4.13, Charter, shall take effect upon its adoption by Council and approval by the Mayor, otherwise at the earliest period allowed by law.


