

AN ORDINANCE ALLOCATING ORIGINAL AND SUPPLEMENTAL OVERTIME FUNDS FROM THE CITY OF STOW'S BUDGET FOR OVERTIME EXPENDITURES FOR THE POLICE DEPARTMENT IN 2018 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOW, COUNTY OF SUMMIT AND STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. For the operating year 2018 the budget authorized City of Stow overtime expenditures to be limited and restricted to the following amounts for the combined line accounts of the departments specified below:

Police Department \$350,000 through December 2018.


That those overtime expenditures be, and they hereby are, amended to read henceforth as follows:


Police Department Up to \$450,000 through December 2018.

SECTION 2. This Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any committees and subcommittees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance was adopted pursuant to Section 4.11 Charter, and is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health and safety for the reason that adequate overtime funds need to be allocated to said department to provide necessary protection to the community, and, pursuant to Section 4.13 Charter, shall take effect upon its adoption by Council and approval by the Mayor, otherwise at the earliest period allowed by law.


