

RESOLUTION NO. 2018-127

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF STOW TO ACCEPT GRANT FUNDS FOR THE PURPOSE OF PURCHASING SOURCE CAPTURE EXHAUST EXTRACTION SYSTEMS FOR FIRE STATION NOS. 2 AND 3 FROM THE BUREAU OF WORKERS' COMPENSATION (BWC) FIREFIGHTER EXPOSURE TO ENVIRONMENTAL ELEMENTS GRANT (FEEEG) AND SAFETY INTERVENTION GRANT (SIG) AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Stow has been awarded a Bureau of Workers' Compensation (BWC) Firefighter Exposure to Environmental Elements Grant (FEEEG) and Safety Intervention Grant (SIG) for Source Capture Exhaust Extraction Systems for Fire Station Nos. 2 and 3; and

WHEREAS, the cost of the equipment is \$72,357.55 and the City has been awarded up to \$55,000.000 towards the purchase and installation of the equipment for the two stations;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOW, COUNTY OF SUMMIT AND STATE OF OHIO:


SECTION 1. That the Mayor be, and he hereby is, authorized to accept grant funds from the Bureau of Workers' Compensation (BWC) Firefighter Exposure to Environmental Elements Grant (FEEEG) and Safety Intervention Grant (SIG) in an amount not to exceed Fifty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$55,000.00) for the purchase of Source Capture Exhaust Extraction Systems for Fire Station Nos. 2 and 3.

SECTION 2. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.


