

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A TRUST FUND (FUND 878) TITLED "METRO SWAT FUND" TO RECEIVE REVENUES FROM OTHER GOVERNMENTAL ENTITIES AND DONATIONS FROM OTHER SOURCES TO BE USED FOR EXPENDITURES OF METRO SWAT AS SPECIFIED BY THEIR EXECUTIVE BOARD AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, it is necessary to establish a Metro SWAT trust fund for the City to receive and expend monies for the purpose of the Metro SWAT team; and

WHEREAS, Stow will receive staffing credit for serving as the accounting entity for Metro SWAT;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOW, COUNTY OF SUMMIT AND STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That a trust fund titled "Metro SWAT Fund" and number 878 is hereby established to receive revenues from other governmental entities and donations from other sources being dedicated to the Metro SWAT Fund, to be separately established by Council, pursuant to the Metro SWAT Executive Board's directive beginning with the initial transfer as certified by the Village of Silver Lake Treasurer.


SECTION 2. Funds paid into this fund may be expended only on the approval of the Metro SWAT Executive Board or its President or any other organization official as provided in their Board Minutes.

SECTION 3. That the Finance Director be, and he hereby is, authorized and directed to place all monies received into the Metro SWAT Fund and expend such monies authorized in accordance with City Finance Department and other City procedures.

SECTION 4. This Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees or subcommittees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.

SECTION 5. That this Ordinance was adopted pursuant to Section 4.11, Charter, and shall take effect thirty (30) days after its adoption by Council and approval by the Mayor, otherwise at the earliest period allowed by law.
