

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE TO ADVERTISE AND SOLICIT BIDS, ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF STOW, FOR THE PURCHASE OF MATERIALS FOR 2019; AUTHORIZING AND ADOPTING PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS PREPARED BY THE CITY OF STOW THEREFOR; AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO MAKE AND ENTER INTO CONTRACTS FOR SAID MATERIALS SO LONG AS PROPER AUTHORIZATION IS FIRST OBTAINED IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 173.05, C.O.S.

WHEREAS, the City Administration has recommended that it is necessary to enter into contracts for the purchase of materials for 2019; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary for the City to comply with the competitive bid precepts of Ohio law and the enactments of this Council governing the awarding of contracts; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary for this Council to clearly indicate its assent so long as the same is accomplished in accordance with law;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOW, COUNTY OF SUMMIT AND STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Director of Public Service be, and he hereby is, authorized and directed to prepare plans and specifications, or to have the same prepared, and thereafter, to advertise and solicit bids, according to statutory law, for the purchase of materials for 2019 on behalf of the City of Stow. The Law Director shall review the completed bid package(s) for legal form and correctness prior to advertisement.


SECTION 2. That the Mayor be, and he hereby is, authorized and directed to make and enter into contracts with the lowest responsive and responsible bidders for said materials as specified in Section 1 hereof, according to statutory law, so long as the proper authorization for such contracts has first been secured in accordance with Section 173.05, C.O.S. and adequate appropriations exist.

SECTION 3. That this Council does hereby adopt, ratify, and confirm the plans and specifications, profiles and estimates of cost hereby delegated to be prepared by the proper officers of the City of Stow, under the authority of the Director of Public Service.

SECTION 4. This Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any committees or subcommittees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.

SECTION 5. That this Ordinance was adopted pursuant to Section 4.11 Charter, and shall take effect thirty (30) days after its adoption by Council and approval by the Mayor, otherwise at the earliest period allowed by law.


