

ORDINANCE NO. 2019-13

INTRODUCED BY D'ANTONIO

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AN EXPENDITURE FOR THE FLEET REPAIR/MAINTENANCE OF VEHICLES FOR THE POLICE DEPARTMENT, FROM PREFERRED SOURCE AND SOLE SOURCE VENDOR KLABEN FORD LINCOLN, INC., WITHOUT THE NECESSITY OF PUBLIC BIDS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Service Director has requested authorization for the expenditure for the fleet repair/maintenance of vehicles for the Police Department from Preferred Source and Sole Source vendor Klaben Ford Lincoln, Inc., pursuant to C.O.S. Sections 173.07(a)(1)G and 173.07(b)(1)D; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 173.10, C.O.S., the total amount of the expenditure requires legislative approval by this Council;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOW, COUNTY OF SUMMIT AND STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Finance Director be, and he hereby is, authorized to appropriate, encumber, and pay funds in an amount not to exceed Seventy Thousand and 00/100 Dollars (\$70,000.00) to Preferred Source and Sole Source Vendor Klaben Ford Lincoln, Inc. for the fleet repair/maintenance of vehicles for the Police Department for the year 2019.

SECTION 2. This Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any committees or subcommittees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.


SECTION 3. That this ordinance was adopted pursuant to Section 4.11 Charter, and is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health and safety for the reason that the Police Department must maintain a reliable fleet of vehicles in order to insure a timely response to emergencies, and, pursuant to Section 4.13, Charter, shall take effect upon its adoption by Council and approval by the Mayor, otherwise at the earliest period allowed by law.
