ORDINANCE NO. 2019-14

AN ORDINANCE CONFIRMING THE APPOINTMENT OF DEBORAH BERKEY TO THE POSITION OF EXECUTIVE SECRETARY IN THE MAYOR'S OFFICE OF THE CITY OF STOW; ESTABLISHING COMPENSATION FOR SAID APPOINTEE; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Mayor has recommended that Deborah Berkey be appointed to the position of Executive Secretary in the Mayor's Office of the City of Stow; and

WHEREAS, this Council deems that the appointee herein does possess the qualities necessary to fulfill the position of Executive Secretary in the Mayor's Office;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOW, COUNTY OF SUMMIT AND STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the appointment of Deborah Berkey to the position of Executive Secretary in the Mayor's Office be, and the same is, hereby confirmed by this Council.


SECTION 2. That said appointee shall be in the unclassified service of this City, and shall perform such duties as are required by the Mayor.

SECTION 3. That the Finance Director be, and he hereby is, authorized and directed to pay unto said Deborah Berkey the sum of \$23.75 per hour, which, along with employee benefits, shall be in accordance with the general payroll ordinance of the City of Stow.

SECTION 4. This Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any committees or subcommittees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.


SECTION 5. This Ordinance was adopted pursuant to Section 4.11, Charter, and is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health and safety for the reason of ensuring that sufficient staffing is in place to carry out the responsibilities as assigned by the Mayor and Charter of the City of Stow, and, pursuant to Section 4.13, Charter, shall take effect upon its adoption by Council and approval by the Mayor, otherwise at the earliest period allowed by law.
