

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AN EXPENDITURE FOR THE PURCHASE OF FUEL FOR VARIOUS DEPARTMENTS IN THE CITY FROM STATE BID LIST VENDOR PORT PETROLEUM COMPANY INC. AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Chief of Staff/Service Director has requested authorization for the purchase of fuel for various departments in the City from State Bid List Vendor Port Petroleum Company, Inc. pursuant to Sections 173.07(a)(1)F and 173.07(b)(1)C; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 173.10, C.O.S., the total amount of the expenditure requires legislative approval by this Council;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOW, COUNTY OF SUMMIT AND STATE OF OHIO:


SECTION 1. That the Finance Director be, and he hereby is, authorized to appropriate, encumber, and pay funds in an amount not to exceed One-Hundred Two Thousand and 00/100 Dollars (\$102,000.00) to State Bid List Vendor Port Petroleum Company, Inc. for the purchase of diesel fuel and pay funds in an amount not to exceed One-Hundred Eighty Thousand and 00/100 (\$180,000) to State Bid List Vendor Port Petroleum Company, Inc. for the purchase of unleaded fuel.

SECTION 2. This Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any committees or subcommittees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance was adopted pursuant to Section 4.11, Charter, and is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health and safety for the reason that fuel is a necessity for many departments in order for them to do their jobs, and, pursuant to Section 4.13, Charter, shall take effect upon its adoption by Council and approval by the Mayor, otherwise at the earliest period allowed by law.
