

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO MAKE AND ENTER INTO A REVISED AND CONTINUING AGREEMENT WITH THE COUNTY OF SUMMIT AND CITY OF AKRON FOR PURPOSES OF GOVERNING THE USE AND MAINTENANCE OF THE 800 MHZ RADIO SYSTEM, WITHOUT THE NECESSITY OF PUBLIC BIDS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Stow is authorized by law to expend funds, without the necessity of public bids, to a sole source provider pursuant to C.O.S. Sections 173.07(a)(1)G and C.O.S. 173.07(b)(1)A; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ordinance No. 2006-94, the Mayor entered into an agreement with the County of Summit and the City of Akron for purposes of governing the use and maintenance of the 800 MHz radio system; and

WHEREAS, the agreement needs to be revised and requires the approval of City Council;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STOW, COUNTY OF SUMMIT AND STATE OF OHIO:


SECTION 1. That the Mayor be, and he hereby is, authorized to make and enter into a revised and continuing contract with the County of Summit and City of Akron without the necessity of public bids for purposes of governing the use and maintenance of the 800 MHz Radio System.

SECTION 2. This Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any committees or subcommittees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance was adopted pursuant to Section 4.11 Charter, and is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health and safety for the reason that in the event of a disaster we would be able to communicate with other communities within Summit County, and, pursuant to Section 4.13 Charter, shall take effect upon its adoption by Council and approval by the Mayor, otherwise at the earliest period allowed by law.


